

# Sg Semenyih pollution papers to be sent to A-GC

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The investigation papers on the first case of water odour pollution in Sungai Semenyih are now in the process of being sent to the Attorney-General's Chambers, said Natural Resources and Environment Minister Datuk Seri Dr Wan Junaidi Tuanku Jaafar.

"It is now with the ministry's legal adviser and will be submitted to the Attorney-General's Chambers for further action," he said yesterday.

He said in the second case, which involved Sungai Semantan in Pahang, the Department of Environment would work with the Water Regulatory Body, local authorities, Pengurusan Air Pahang, as well as the Irrigation and Drainage Department, to monitor and investigate premises in Bentong.

"The latest case in Negri Sembilan involving Sungai Buah is still under investigation.

"An integrated probe headed by the ministry is in progress," he said.
