

Pupils studying amid contaminated floodwater

KLANG: Some 130 pupils of a primary school here have been studying in cramped conditions after the building was flooded on Monday.

While the water has receded in most areas nearby, it remained the same at SJK(T) Bukit Raja.

Sewage is also believed to have contaminated the water.

The pupils are studying in the school's old building 100 metres away.

A. Gunasegaran, 42, said even if the water was pumped out, it would still take a couple of days to clean up the mess. "I have four children studying here and the whole area is a health hazard."

Klang Municipal councillor Alex Thiagarasan said a housing developer should resolve the problem quickly. "It's clear that development work is responsible for this sorry sight."
