

## KUANTAN CENTRES CLOSE

# Flood situation in Pahang improves

**KUANTAN:** The flood situation in Pahang has improved significantly and all relief centres in Kuantan, which was the worst-hit district in the past week, have closed.

At the height of the floods, more than 7,000 people in the district were evacuated.

Seri Damai hall was the last re-

lief centre to close at 4pm.

According to the Welfare Department's flood portal, only 407 people from 111 families remained at three relief centres in Pekan, Maran and Bera.

There are 290 evacuees from 78 families in Pekan, 74 evacuees from 20 families in Maran and 43 evacuees from 13 families in Bera.

A state Civil Defence Force spokesman said sunny skies for a second consecutive day led to the closing of the relief centres in Kuantan and Temerloh and evacuees returning home.

He said the majority of the flood-hit schools which were closed last week were expected to open tomorrow.
