Village in Kelantan cut off by flood waters

PASIR PUTEH: Twenty-six residents from five families in Kampung Tok Kundur, here, have been cut off from neighbouring areas as the road to the village is under 0.5 metre of flood waters.

Pasir Puteh Fire and Rescue Station chief, Elmi Mustofar said the flood was due to heavy rain since yesterday.

"Residents here should always be alert and be prepared from now for possible evacuation if the downpour continues and worsens the situation," he told reporters when visiting the village today.

According to the Drainage and Irrigation Department's website at <http://infobanjir.water.gov.my> (<http://infobanjir.water.gov.my>), the water level in Sungai Semerak has risen to 0.49 metre from 0.40 metre at 1 pm. The danger level is three metres. - Bernama
