

200 power stations ^{21/12} _{STK} turned off

JOHOR BARU: More than 200 Tenaga Nasional Bhd (TNB) substations statewide have been switched off due to massive floods, and some 3,500 consumers are affected by the power cut.

Johor TNB general manager (distribution) Mohammad Mokhtar Mohd Ali said the move was for security reasons.

He urged consumers to be alert and careful during the rainy and flood season, adding that if they were forced to vacate their homes, they must remember to switch off the mains.

Those who are stranded and notice that cables have snapped should immediately call the TNB hotline 15454.

Syarikat Air Johor Holdings (SAJH) corporate communications chief Jamaluddin Jamil said so far 10 tankers had been dispatched to affected districts statewide.
