

Free replacement of personal documents

KUALA LUMPUR: Flood victims whose personal documents like MyKad and MyKid identification cards, birth and marriage certificates and passports were lost or damaged can have them replaced for free, Deputy Home Minister Datuk Tan Chai Ho said. He said the National Registration Department would send its mobile teams to assist the victims concerned at the flood-hit areas. "However, they (victims) must lodge police reports on the loss or damage of the documents and obtain a letter from the Welfare Department to verify that they are victims of a natural disaster," he told reporters after the presentation of a RM28,000 grant for dyslexia research by the Bandar Tun Razak Education Foundation to Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia yesterday. — Bernama
