

Floods are only in Tumpat now

KOTA BARU: The floods in Kelantan are now confined to the Tumpat district with 1,439 evacuees still at three relief centres.

All the evacuees in Pasir Mas have been allowed to return to their homes and the five relief centres in the district have been closed, said a spokesman of the Kelantan police flood operations room.

At the height of the third wave of floods in the state over the past week, 3,441 people were evacuated to 27 relief centres in six districts, namely Tanah Merah, Kota Baru, Pasir Mas, Tumpat, Pasir Puteh and Bachok.

The spokesman said only stretches at the 6th km and 9th km of Jalan Cabang 4 / Kg Jambu/Meranti remained closed to light vehicles yesterday afternoon.

The level of the swollen Golok River was dropping and was 9.18m this afternoon, but still above the danger mark of 9m, he added. – Bernama
