

Floods cut off roads in Kuantan

KUANTAN: A continuous downpour caused flooding in the Indera Mahkota area here and affected several roads.

The downpour, which started at about 5pm yesterday, caused roads to Indera Mahkota 14 and 15 from Bukit Rangin and near the Kompleks Belia to be flooded.

Roads were submerged by about 0.6m.

Motorists were forced to turn back instead of continuing their journey while some had to push their vehicles to higher ground with the help of their passengers.

Traffic police were on standby to

stop other vehicles from using the roads and also helped motorists move their cars, which stalled due to the flood waters. As of press time, the waters had not subsided.

Last Sunday, flash floods had hit Kuantan town. Both areas are not known to be prone to floods.
