

All evacuees in Pasir Puteh return home

KUALA LUMPUR: The floods in Pasir Puteh, Kelantan, have receded with all evacuation centres closed while the number of victims in Terengganu and Johor has remained unchanged from Tuesday.

Some schools in Kelantan remained closed while in Terengganu, all schools began the new term on Tuesday.

In **Kelantan**, the state government's flood portal stated that the last 18 flood evacuees at SK Bukit Awang, Pasir Puteh, returned to their homes yesterday.

Nevertheless, seven schools in Rantau Panjang and Tumpat were forced to remain closed until the situation returned to normal.

Awang had advised department staff and parents to follow developments on the situation.

In **Terengganu**, the number of victims in Setiu yesterday morning remained at 64.

According to the state government's flood portal, only one evacuation centre remained open.

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
