

More rain to hit Perak and Selangor

KUALA LUMPUR: Be ready for more floods as the Drainage and Irrigation Department issued warnings on rising water levels of rivers in Selangor and Perak.

The department's website warned of rising water levels in Sungai Langat near Bukit Changgang and Sungai Selangor near Kuala Badong and Rantau Panjang.

It also warned of heavy rain in Sungai Kinta (near Kuala Pari), Sungai Perak (near Parit), Pendang and Samagagah in Perak.

Warnings were also issued for Sungai Labu (near Kampung Salak Tinggi) in Sepang, Selangor and in Tebedu near Serian, Sarawak.

The National Security Council's website also showed 1,045 victims still sheltered at six centres in Kuala Langat and Sepang in Selangor.

In Malacca, 76 victims are still seeking shelter at a relief centre in Jasin while in Johor, 756 victims remained at five relief centres around Batu Pahat.
