

Khalid slammed over floods

SHAH ALAM: Dusun Tua assemblyman Ismail Sani yesterday questioned the state government's failure to alleviate flooding problem in Sungai Serai, Hulu Langat.

The Barisan Nasional assemblyman said the issue had been raised since 2008 with Selangor Menteri Besar Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim giving his pledge to solve the problem but until now nothing was done. Ismail said the majority of Sungai Serai residents were disappointed with the current state government

for its failure to solve the problem.

"If the state can allocate RM300 million for the construction of the third bridge in Klang, why can they undertake the project which costs less than RM10 million? The menteri besar should not blame others, especially the Federal Government."

Earlier, during the state assembly sitting, Khalid said the state government could not carry out the project because they did not receive the allocation from the Federal Government.
