

2,800 flood victims get RM1.4mil NSC aid

KLANG: The National Security Council (NSC) is distributing RM1.4mil in aid to 2,800 flood victims in three areas in the Kapar parliamentary constituency, Kapar Barisan Nasional chairman Datuk Abdul Rahman Palil said.

He said the 2,300 victims in the Selat Klang area received their payments of RM500 each yesterday while Sementa and Sungai Pinang residents would get theirs on Dec 29.

These people were affected by floods in March, he said after distributing aid at SK Sungai Udang here.

Abdul Rahman, who is the Sementa state assemblyman, said the aid was given by the Federal Government to flood victims. "We are providing aid to all those who have registered and have a police report. We do not ask them which party they vote for," he said.

Zalina Abullah, 29, said the money would help purchase school items for her children.

"I am grateful that the aid will ease our burden," said the resident of Kampung Delek Kiri here. — Bernama
