Klang Valley hit by flash floods, traffic jams

KUALA LUMPUR: Traffic in several highways in the Klang Valley were at a standstill because of flash floods following a downpour yesterday.

A spokesman of Malaysian Highway Authority said that the New Pantai Expressway, Federal High-

way, Bangsar, Subang Jaya and Old Klang Road were badly affected by the rain, which started at 3pm.

"The wet conditions forced the traffic to move slowly from Sri Petaling to the Middle Ring Road 2 on the Kesyas Highway. A similar situation

was reported from Grand Saga Highway toll plaza heading to Plaza Phoenix and the Sunway Toll plaza to the Federal Highway on the Puchong Damansara Highway.

Meanwhile, KTM Berhad was forced to bring its services

to a halt.

Through its Twitter account, @ktmkomuter, it tweeted that train services in the Klang Valley would make the last stop at the Setia Jaya station. However, KTM resumed its services at 5.41pm.
