KUALA LUMPUR: Flash floods cut off several roads in the capital yesterday causing vehicles to be stranded.

A traffic police spokesman said at least eight locations were reported to be flooded following heavy rain which started about 2.30pm.

Among the roads hit by the flood were Besraya Highway, Taman Shamelin in Cheras, and the Billion roundabout, also in Cheras.

The road heading to Seremban near the RMAF base in Sungai Besi, Jalan Peel, and the road opposite the National Heart Institute were also affected.

Many vehicles were stranded at the Besraya Highway and the interchange to Seremban.

The heavy rain caused water to rise by 0.5m at some places. — Bernama
