

Warning of strong winds, choppy seas

KUALA LUMPUR: Strong winds and choppy seas reported in the waters of Condore, Reef North, Layang-Layang and Palawan are expected until today.

The Meteorological Department said yesterday north-easterly winds with speeds of between 50 and 60kph, and waves of up to 4.5m high were expected in the area.

The condition is dangerous for shipping and coastal activities, including fishing and ferry services.

Strong winds between 40 and 50 kph, and waves as high as 3.5m in the waters off Samui, Tioman, Bungan, Reef South and Labuan are expected until tomorrow.

Similar conditions are expected in the waters off Kelantan, Terengganu, Pahang, East Johor, Sabah (Kudat, West Coast and Pedalaman), Labuan and Sarawak, which will be dangerous to small boats, and sea recreation and sports.

The sea level in Kelantan, Terengganu, Pahang and East Johor had risen but was expected to ease yesterday. **Bernama**
