

Selangor flood victims down to 497

SHAH ALAM: The number of flood victims in Selangor is down to 497 people from 130 families at 7pm today compared to 625 victims from 161 families in the morning as flood waters subsided in several areas.

Selangor Fire and Rescue Department operations assistant director Mohd Sani Harul said two relief centres, the Kampung Salak Community Centre in Sepang and Klang Municipal Council Hall in Kampung Kuantan, Klang have been closed as all victims have returned home.

As of 7pm, eight relief centres are still operating in Selangor, two in Sepang, three in Kuala Selangor, two in Klang and one in Kuala Langat.

The relief centre at Dewan Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Meru in Klang still shelters the highest number of flood victims with 184 from 46 families. Other relief centres are Taman Gemilang Hall in Dengkil (47 victims), and Surau RTB Labu Lanjut (84), in Sepang, Kampung Parit Mahang Community Hall (28), Surau Ladang Tuan Mee (40 victims), and Surau At-Taufikiah, Puncak Alam (7 victims) in Kuala Selangor, Sekolah Kebangsaan Abdul Samad, Kapar (58) in Klang and Genting Sanyen Community Hall (49) in Kuala Langat.

The victims include 18 babies, 14 senior citizens and six disabled people.
