

No water rationing, says Kedah

ALOR STAR: The lack of rainfall in Kedah over the past few weeks has had little effect on the water levels of its three main dams.

Muda Agricultural Development Authority (Mada) said the water levels at the Pedu, Muda and Ahning dams remained healthy.

"The levels at the three dams are 94.89m (Pedu), 99.59m (Muda) and 109.48m (Ahning).

"The capacity of the dams is good.

"There is nothing to worry about," Mada deputy chairman for logistics, Ho Teik Li, told the *New Straits Times* here yesterday.

On whether there would be water rationing, state Local Government, Water Supply, Water Resources, Energy, Housing and Human Capital Committee chairman Datuk Badrul Hisham Hashim said: "The water levels at the dams are good.

"So, there will not be water rationing."
