

Selangor dams at over 70pc level

SHAH ALAM: Raw water levels at Sungai Selangor and Sungai Tinggi dams, where 60 per cent of their supply is channelled to Selangor, Kuala Lumpur and Putrajaya, are at more than 70 per cent.

According to the Selangor Waters Management Authority's website, the capacity levels recorded at the dams as of 8am yesterday were at 88.6 per cent for Sungai Selangor and 89 per cent at Sungai Tinggi.

The readings for other dams were also good, with the Batu dam recording 83.36 per cent water level, Semenyih dam at 87.22 per cent, Sun-

gai Langat dam at 70.38 per cent, Klang Gates dam at 83.07 per cent and Tasik Subang dam at 97.82 per cent.

State Tourism, Consumer Affairs, Green Technology and Environ-

ment Committee chairman Elizabeth Wong said the state government would be informed if there was a need for cloud seeding to boost water levels at the dams.

"Cloud seeding is only done with

advice from the Meteorological Department. For the exercise to be successful, we require certain clouds in the vicinity of the targeted area, with adequate amount of wind in the right direction," she said.
