Perlis folk urged to conserve water

KANGAR: The people of Perlis have been urged to conserve water as there is a possibility that water rationing will be carried out in the state.

As at 12.30pm yesterday, the water level at the Timah Tasoh Dam had dropped another 0.03m to 26.26m.

“We cannot use water the way we have been using it.

“The people have to be disciplined in using water.

“It will help a lot should water rationing be carried out,” said Perlis Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Azlan Man after the state assembly sitting yes-

terday, which was adjourned after a two-day debate.

Azlan said should the dam’s water level drop to 26.2m, water rationing would be unavoidable.

Cloud seeding is being carried out in Perlis, Pahang and Kedah for a week, and began on Tuesday.
