Rain inundates m-cycle lane

FEDERAL HIGHWAY: Three-hour downpour causes water level to rise up to one metre

A THREE-HOUR downpour in the Klang Valley led to flash floods in the motorcycle lane of the Federal Highway, sparking a temporary closure yesterday.

Selangor Fire and Rescue Department assistant director (Operations) Mohd Sani Harul said heavy rain caused the water level in the lane to rise up to 1m as at 5.30pm.

The water level of the drainage system nearby stood at 5.71m.

“There were no casualties recorded in the incident.

“However, the motorcycle lane has been temporarily closed off for the time being,” he said.

Sani said several areas in Selangor also recorded flash floods, but the situation was under control.

In **Subang**, the water level increased to 0.3m as at 5pm, while the water level increased to 0.6m in Jalan Tempinis here due to the downpour.

However, Sani said the water levels at the areas gradually receded by 7pm.
